

Conservatory Designs

Victorian

The classic Victorian style gives a nostalgic appearance that adds charm, elegance and character to any home. Adding a hip to the back of the roof allows the Victorian to fit onto a bungalow or a low pitched roof.



Edwardian

The square fronted style gives the optimum internal floor space with an elegant hipped roof and bold strong lines. It makes an ideal extension to any home. The style can also incorporate a box gutter making it suitable for low eaves bungalows.



Gable

For a really striking effect combined with the maximum floor space this version can have a plain or decorative gable. It is ideal for a glass roof and suitable for almost any style of property where a light and airy feel and distinct appearance are required.



Lean To

The traditional lean to is the most practical and cost effective way to add space – flexible in design the roof pitch can be varied to suit almost any situation. Roofs can be hipped to add style or the corners rounded to give the beauty of a Victorian design whilst being just a little different.



P Shape

The P Shape combines a mix of Lean-to and Victorian or Edwardian styles. They provide the maximum amount of space whilst maintaining the overall proportions of the conservatory in keeping with the property and garden.
